Greetings from IFCCI!

I would like to take a moment to reflect on the accomplishments of the last few months and highlight that our dedication and commitment to enhancing the impact of the 17 IFCCI committees, which play a vital role in the success of our chamber, have remained steadfast.

These committees not only encourage CXOs of our member companies to collectively shape industry agendas but also serve as invaluable platforms, providing exclusive access to sector-specific information, giving an opportunity to meet the Government of India to discuss industry concerns, fostering networking opportunities, and facilitating the exchange of innovative business ideas with other members.

Building on the success of our committee-specific events and initiatives in India, we are strategically expanding our efforts and have focused on curating impactful advocacy programs and enhanced engagement with Governmental authorities.

IFCCI recently conducted a series of high-level roundtable meetings with Ministry of Consumer Affairs and DPIIT, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Govt. of India around select sectors such as Food and Agribusiness, Logistics, Supply Chain, Mobility, Industries and Energy & Utilities. Such engagements allow IFCCI to advocate for the interests as well as concerns of Indian and French companies and provide feedback on regulatory frameworks.

Several committees have witnessed flagship events in the last few months and in addition to this, we conducted 40 interactive sessions on a wide range of topics including perfumery, branding, reskilling, compensation, workplace stress, logistics, artificial intelligence, retail trends and a site visit to Bureau Veritas Lab.

Apart from high level engagements for the CEO committee, the CSR Department which works very closely with the CSR Committee, has taken off since last year and I am glad to share that the Department has completed 3 CSR projects with Air Liquide, Socomec and Yale Synthlube in a span of 9 months and more projects are underway.

IFCCI is now set to organize a session on 'the Essential Guide to Expat Compensation and Benefits in India, a 'learning session on Key Industry Trends with LinkedIn, the second Edition of the 'Indo-French Sustainability Conclave' and a Site Visit to Valeo Plant in Chennai in the month of June.


#### 'France and India: Charting a Course for a Better Future'
